History brought alive – Mr Fraser Barbour, a surgeon from 1853, can regale guests with stories of working as a surgeon at that time. He is available for drinks receptions or as an after dinner speaker.

Our Fellows Library and Logan Turner Room can cater for small intimate dinner parties. Both rooms have a wonderful ambience and items and portraits in the rooms are a great talking point during dinner.

In contrast, we have the King Khalid Building, a sympathetically restored Church, and our Quincentenary Building a beautiful modern building which can be dressed dramatically to suit every occasion.
